### Points of Attention for the Revolution

The Revolution Club upholds, lives by and fights for the following principles:

- 1** We base ourselves on and strive to represent the highest interests of humanity: revolution and communism. We do not tolerate using the revolution for personal gain.
- 2** We fight for a world where ALL the chains are broken. Women, men, and differently gendered people are equals and comrades. We do not tolerate physically or verbally abusing women or treating them as sexual objects, nor do we tolerate insults or "jokes" about people's gender or sexual orientation.
- 3** We fight for a world without borders, and for equality among different peoples, cultures and languages. We do not tolerate insults, "jokes" or derogatory names about a person's race, nationality, or language.
- 4** We stand with the most oppressed and never lose sight of their potential to emancipate humanity—nor of our responsibility to lead them to do that. We work to win people of all backgrounds to take part in the revolution, and do not tolerate revenge among the people.
- 5** We search for and fight for the truth no matter how unpopular, even as we listen to and learn from the observations, insights and criticisms of others.
- 6** We are going for an actual overthrow of this system and a whole better way beyond the destructive, vicious conflicts of today between the people. Because we are serious, at this stage we do not initiate violence and we oppose all violence against the people and among the people.

**Bob Avakian says, "We, the masses of people, are capable of much greater things than this. We are capable of completely and radically changing our circumstances, changing all of society to get rid of circumstances like these. What happens in the world affects us and we can affect the world, and when all is said and done, we can change the whole world, together with people like us all over the world."**

## Fighting the Power & Transforming the People for Revolution

Every day the Revolution Club is struggling with people to stop being played into thinking that the enemy is someone just like them living right down the street, and instead to get ready and organized to fight to overthrow the real enemy, the system that has created, and has them locked in, the conditions, the misery, and the poverty that has them at each other's throats in the first place. They are arguing with youth to stop thirsting for retaliation and revenge, and to get out of the "me and mine first" mindset and to become emancipators of all humanity. This summer, especially the young men are being struggled with to know that women are not bitches, ho's, punching bags, incubators, sex objects, or breeders—women are full human beings. The Club is challenging youth to refuse to join the military, to not fight for their oppressors, but to fight to overthrow this system. The Club argues for everyone to search for and fight for the truth.

This is a real battle and it requires standing up against police terrorizing whole neighborhoods and communities to prevent this message from being spread. When people in a South Side Chicago neighborhood, joined by the Revolution Club, stood up to police intimidation, the cops retaliated against the whole neighborhood, imposing an "unofficial" martial law, including trying to enforce a 7a.m. to 3p.m. ban on being on the street! Police have **literally** ordered youth to take off the Revolution t-shirts. The Club defied this and 5 were arrested on bogus charges. The next day was a different story, as the Club returned to hold a rally and a face-off with the police which drew important support, as many stepped forward and put on the BA Speaks- Revolution, Nothing Less! t-shirts right in front of the police commander. Over 92,000 people watched a video of the arrests, which sparked an intense debate online and in the neighborhood and beyond.

The Revolution Club, Chicago, says this: **We mean what we say, and we will not back off or turn our back on what we have started, on the people who need this revolution. We will keep coming back and digging in, to strengthen this movement for revolution, to build up the bases, spread the influence, and organize the forces we need to make revolution. We will not be scared off, backed down or driven away.**

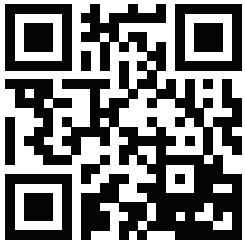
