



October 2005. For more than three decades, Texaco (now Chevron) deliberately dumped billions of gallons of toxic wastewater into the rivers and streams, spilled millions of gallons of crude oil, burned more than 235 billion cubic feet of natural gas into the atmosphere, and abandoned hazardous waste into hundreds of unlined toxic waste pits throughout Ecuador's Amazonian region. This resulted in widespread devastation of the rainforest ecosystem and of local indigenous communities. (AP photo)
