Ten Ways You Can Be A Part of Building the Movement for Revolution

- Begin listening to the Revolution talk, Revolution: Why It's Necessary, Why It's Possible, What It's All About by the revolutionary leader Bob Avakian. It's available in DVD at Revolution Books or on line at revolutiontalk.net. Listen to some of the talk every day. Read BAsics, the book of quotations and short essays by Bob Avakian. This enables you to get deeper into the ideas that guide the revolution BA's new synthesis of communism and a strategy to bring it into being.
- Check out the Constitution for the New Socialist Republic in North America (Draft Proposal) from the Revolutionary Communist Party.

 A different world is possible. This is an actual PLAN for a radically different society, in all its dimensions. Open up the conversation & debate about whether this is the best or only way the world could be vs. a vision of a whole new world.
- **Spread the Revolution.** Sign up for e-mails from revolutionbooksnyc.org; forward links; tweet and spread the word via social media to friends and e-lists. Tape up a revolutionary poster or an article from *Revolution* newspaper on bulletin boards, hallways, bathroom stalls, or hand out palm cards. Get the word out and let people see that there are other people who support the revolution.
- Donate and raise funds for the campaign to project Bob Avakian's vision and works into every corner of society. Imagine what a difference it could make if people knew about and engaged this pathbreaking work. Be a part of building this campaign of "BA Everywhere" letting everyone know about, and get into, the new synthesis of communism that BA has brought forward and the leadership he's giving to the movement for revolution.
- **Fight the Power, and Transform the People, for Revolution.** People need to fight back, and people do fight back, against the many ways human beings, and the environment, are exploited, degraded, ravaged and even destroyed by this system. But to make that fight more powerful and to carry it through to *put an end to all this* people need to learn that the *fundamental problem is this capitalist system*, and the solution is getting rid of it and bringing into being *a new system*, *socialism*, aiming for the final goal of a communist world.

- Check out and join the Revolution Club. The Revolution Club is for people who feel that: "The days when this system can just keep on doing what it does to people, here and all over the world...when people are not inspired and organized to stand up against these outrages and to build up the strength to put an end to this madness...those days must be GONE. And they CAN be." The Rev Club is organized around two basic ideas: Humanity Needs Revolution and Communism and Fight the Power, and Transform the People, for Revolution.
- "Blow the Whistle on Stop & Frisk" on September 13. Join the campaign to have a single day when 10,000 people blow whistles to make sure that nobody gets stopped and frisked in silence. Support and defend Noche Diaz, who is being targeted as a young revolutionary leader of the movement against Stop & Frisk. Organize on your campus to attend his trial together on Sept. 5. - Read *Revolution* newspaper every week on line or get a sub to the print edition. Learn what's really going on in the world and stay connected to the movement for revolution. Post key articles from *Revolution* and contribute reports to the paper. E-subs are available at revcom.us.
- Open up the discussion and debate on campus or in a coffee house about the way forward. The air is filled with calls to vote for the lessor of 2 evils, to restrict the fight to this or that minor reform as things get horribly worse, to live "responsibly" while the planet is destroyed, or to just do good in a bad world while passively awaiting better times. *Enough*. Arrange a debate on your campus or in your community between these dead ends and the Revolution. Invite a revolutionary to come speak in your class, club, or dorm.
- Come to, shop at, volunteer for, and sustain Revolution Books. Revolution Books is where you can find the books and the deep engagement about why the world is the way it is and the possibility of a radically different way the world could be . . . a bookstore at the center of building a movement for revolution
