The Prisoners Revolutionary Literature Fund (PRLF, www.PrisonersRevolutionary LiteratureFund.org), an educational literature fund and project of the 501(c)(3) International Humanities Center, has filled thousands of requests from men and women who are locked up in U.S. prisons and are seeking revolutionary literature, especially subscriptions to *Revolution* newspaper.

As its Mission Statement says, "Through providing this literature, PRLF provides an educational opportunity for prisoners to engage with world events and key political, cultural, and philosophical questions of the day from a unique revolutionary perspective, including discussions of morality, religion, science, and the arts. Every week prisoners can delve into the urgent and lively news and debate about unfolding political and social struggles, and can critically think about and dissect the current state of society as well as search for an alternative."

PRLF Cannot Provide Prisoners with Revolutionary Literature Each Year and Keep Up with the Growing Demand WITHOUT YOU

Prisoners Revolutionary Literature Fund urgently needs your help to renew over 800 prisoner subscriptions to *Revolution* that will come due by the end of 2009, at a cost of \$14,000 for 6 months. Funding new subscriptions to 160 of the prisoners now on PRLF's waiting list requires another \$5,600 for one year. Prisoners' frequent requests for revolutionary literature, in addition to subscriptions to *Revolution* newspaper, include the books *The Science of Evolution and the Myth of Creationism* by Ardea Skybreak, and *Away With All Gods! Unchaining the Mind and Radically Changing the World*, by Bob Avakian, Chairman of the Revolutionary Communist Party, USA. And the demand for more revolutionary literature is growing. In addition to the much appreciated individual donations over the years—big and small—PRLF was a beneficiary of some significant events in 2009, including programs in Harlem, NY, Evanston, IL and the Bay Area, California. In July 2009, PRLF was one of two beneficiaries of a dialogue between Cornel West and Carl Dix, which was also broadcast live on New York's WBAI radio. A fund-raising event is being planned in Houston, TX.
