Chicago is known all over the world for people killing each other. Trump is using this to prepare for genocide against Black people overall, while he prepares horrible crimes against all of humanity. The pigs in Chicago use it as an excuse for the brutality and repression and murder they commit. And people all over the planet look, and say, "people will never get out of that stuff the oppressor puts on them," and shake their head in sorrow or shrug their shoulders.

The Revolution Club came to Chicago last summer determined to change all that. We came determined to forge something new in Chicago, a growing force for an actual revolution to emancipate all humanity. We came determined for THAT to be what people see happening in Chicago: where a growing group of people began to take up the cause of revolution and emancipating all of humanity. Where people at the very bottom of society, people who yesterday were into all the madness, *changed* what they were into and what they did. Where people got into the leader of the revolution, Bob Avakian, and the way of thinking he's brought forward. Where people learned the strategy of how to make revolution when the time is ripe, and started to work on hastening that time. Where they learned what will replace this rotten system. Where they took up a whole new morality opposite of the dog-eat-dog that this system drills into people.

We came determined to make people all over the world see Chicago as a place where REVOLUTION was happening. And to get inspired off that to themselves take up revolution.

We had some battles, we learned some things, and now we are going forward. Come be part of getting into this, and talking about how to go forward.

Bob Avakian, leader of the revolution, said in his talk last summer:

This [the situation in Chicago and in specific the demonization and criminalization of the youth] is a gauntlet that's been thrown down by the ruling class, and is objectively a gauntlet that we have to pick up and transform. And there is nobody else who's going to do this—not because of some sort of human nature that we have that's different from other people, but because people don't have the science. They don't have the science to recognize what the actual situation is, what the contradictory situation is. Yes, what the very negative factors are, including in what people are into—not just what they do but how they think, and what needs to be really compellingly struggled with in a very fierce way to rupture them out of that and to get them to actually rise to the potential they have to be emancipators of humanity, to be a backbone of a revolution whose goal is the emancipation of all humanity. And furthermore, having entered into this, there is no way that we are not going to fight through on it. We have to fight through on it because of what it represents objectively, which I was just speaking to. And, on top of that, we have to fight through on it because we've gone to the masses and said we're going to do so. And goddamn it, we're not going to not do that!

We mean what we say, and we will not back off or turn our backs on what we have started, on the people who need this revolution. We will keep coming back and digging in, to strengthen this movement for revolution, to build up the bases, spread the influence and organize the forces we need to make revolution. We will not be scared off, backed down or driven away.
