Just in the past nine months, the U.S. has locked up more than 52,000 children from **Central America who were** caught trying to cross the border, often unaccompanied by adults.* Many are fleeing from extreme poverty, repression, and gang conflicts and trying to reunite with their families. In detention, these kids are subject to horrific conditions.

What kind of a system takes tens of thousands of children fleeing vicious poverty and violent oppression in their homelands and locks them up in cruel concentration camps? And why should **ANYONE find that system** legitimate and tolerable—for a minute?
