


One of These Things Is Not Like the Others, One of These Things Just Doesn't Belong. Can You Guess Which?



ANSWER

If you answered yes to (D), you got it right, but think about why it is right?

The first three are embryos of vertebrates (animals with a backbone, including mammals, birds, reptiles, and fishes). An embryo is a part of the body of a female vertebrate, a tiny clump of cells that is only beginning to form distinct organs and bodily functions. Embryos of all vertebrates start off looking almost exactly the same, and even have the very same number of gill slits, which mark their shared ancestry. Here, (A) is a dolphin embryo, (B) is a human embryo, and (C) is a chicken embryo.

(D) is a child who has been born, is a separate being from the woman who gave birth to her, and can breathe on her own, think, feel and learn. In other words, she is a full human being.
